Target grades are set using historical performance against KS2 results.

They are reviewed regularly.

Forecast grades are made twice a year in every subject. The grades are colour coded, according to the key, against the target grade in order to indicate if the forecast grade aligns with progress projections from KS2.

Independent learner is again a key component of the ideal Lathom Learner profile. It is an indication of how well students present the PROUD ethos within a subject. It includes factors such as homework, involvement with extra-curricular, and the development of skills for future learning.

A barrier to learning is a reason why a student is not hitting their target grade in a subject, or why their Active or Independent Learner is currently not graded as good. Barriers to learning are tracked and lead to intervention where necessary.
